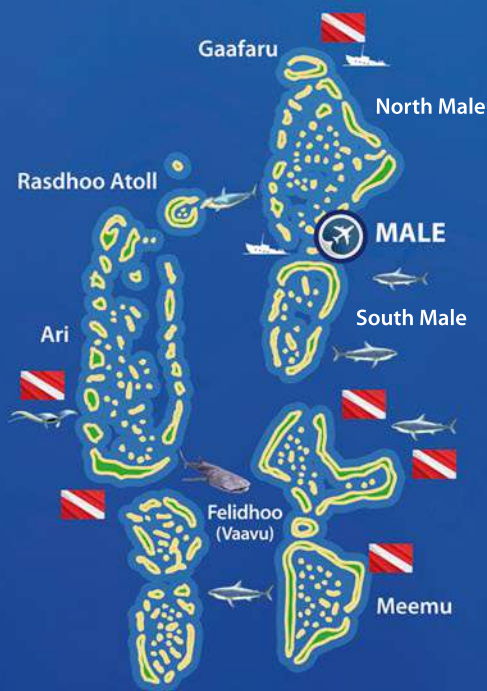

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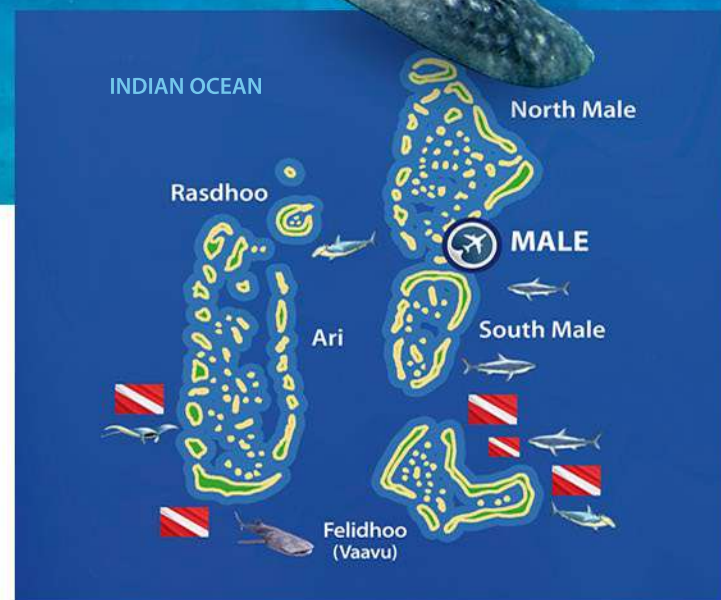
## CENTRAL ATOLLS ROUTE

This is the best well-known route in the Maldives but at the same time it is the one that offers the best and most varied dives. We go on this route 10 months a year (except June) with weekly departures. Thanks to that, we know every detail, atoll, passage, thilas and where and when it is convenient to approach every dive zone.

It is a 7-night route including 6-dive days on board with embarkation and disembarkation at the Male Airport (18 dives with 2-night dives).

The itinerary goes by North Male, South Male, Felidhoo and Ari Atolls.

The aim is to find pelagic, grey sharks, white-tip sharks, black-tip sharks, and in some occasions, hammerheads and dolphins, eagle rays, schools of colorful fishes, morays, tuna fish, gild-head breams, groupers and turtles. Drifting dives in water passages and canals, thilas (submerged coral "seamounts"), cleaning stations where big mantas gather together to be deworn and the search of the whale shark (and if we are lucky will snorkel and even dive with the biggest fish). We will dive into a full-of-life wreck. Besides, there will be two of the most spectacular night dives in the world: one with mantas and the other with dozens of nurse sharks.



Desert islands and typical fishermen villages are also visited to discover and enjoy a bit more of the country and if the weather allows doing so we will even have BBQ lunch on a island.

Although if you are looking to relax, you can enjoy the solarium and the jacuzzi on board, kayak, Paddle SUP...

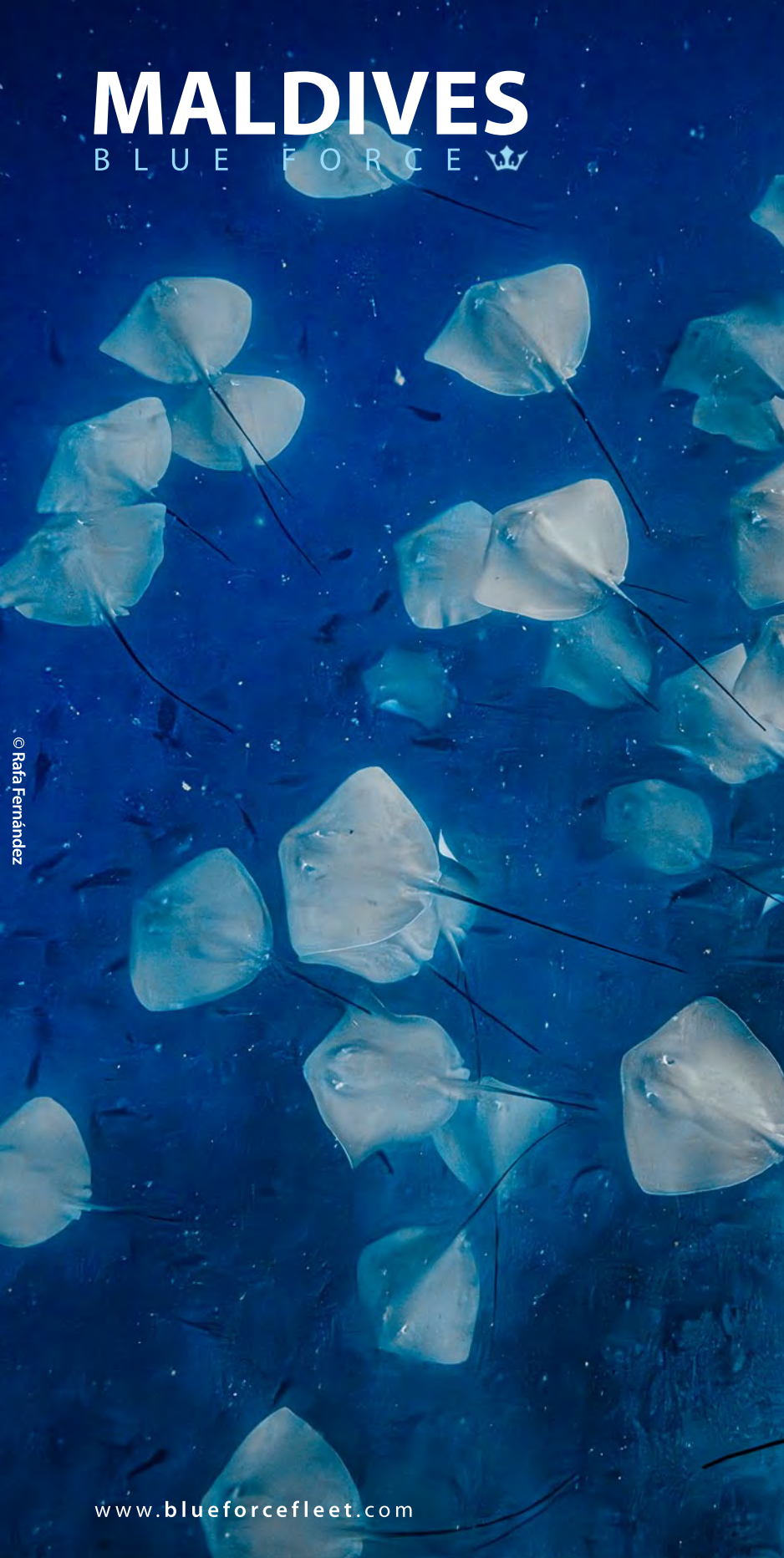

## CRUISE PROGRAM



### Day 1 (Saturday): ARRIVAL TO MALE - EMBARK

Arrival at Male airport. One of our staff members will be waiting for you at Male Airport. You will then get onto our auxiliary boat Dhoni for the transfer to MALDIVES BLUE FORCE ONE or 3 for check in, briefing of the liveaboard, diving and plan itinerary. Dinner onboard.



### Day 2 to 7 (Sunday to Friday): CENTRAL ATOLLS ROUTE

The route will go through North Male, South Male, Felidhoo and Ari atolls. Daily dive program for certified divers including day dives, night dives and possibility of snorkel and dive with Whale sharks (total: 18 dives per week). For non-divers we will offer different activities such as snorkel, kayak, paddle SUP.... If the weather and logistic allow, we will have a BBQ on a desert and will visit some populated island. On Friday afternoon we will anchorage next to Male. So, we will have the option to make a guided visit to Male.



### Day 8 (Saturday): MALE AIRPORT

Disembark at Male Airport at 07.00 am. If the return flight leaves in the afternoon there is an day hotel option near the airport, and even free time to optionally visit Male until the time of the return flight.

Equally important are the sharks as well as the amazing amount of life and color that the seabed of Maldives offers to divers and non-divers. All this is surrounded by an awesome landscape of majestic islands on an exclusive premium cruise.





## CENTRAL ATOLLS & HANIFARU ROUTE

August & September (Consult dates)

### Departure and arrival in Male

### Route: North Male, Baa Atoll, Hanifaru, Rasdoo & Ari

From August to October is the best season to visit the North Atolls in Maldives. We recommend an interesting diving cruise called **MANTA EXPEDITION**. After a first diving day in North Male where we look for a Manta cleaning station, we will sail northbound to the Baa Atoll & Hanifaru Bay. On this atoll we will try to enjoy snorkeling with mantas in the Hanifaru Bay, Biosphere Reserve.

Depending on sea conditions, currents and sightings on that week, and apart from mantas, we will modify the route in search for pelagics in Rasdoo, as well as diving with mantas by night and, with a bit of luck, diving &/or snorkelling with the whale shark on the Ari Atoll.



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## CRUISE PROGRAM - CENTRAL ATOLLS & HANIFARU ROUTE

August & September (Consult dates).



### Day 1 (Saturday): MALE – “CENTRAL ATOLLS & HANIFARU” ROUTE

Arrival at Male airport. One of our staff members will be waiting for you at Male Airport. You will then get onto our auxiliary boat Dhoni for the transfer to MALDIVES BLUE FORCE ONE or 3 for check in, briefing of the liveaboard, diving and plan itinerary. Dinner onboard.



### Day 2-7 (Sunday to Friday): “CENTRAL ATOLLS & HANIFARU” ROUTE

The planned route (although can be modified under the cruise management's criteria) will take a trip around North Male, Hanifaru, Baa, Rasdoo & Ari. During the cruise an 18-dive program is developed (day and night dives & snorkeling in Hanifaru Bay). On Friday afternoon we will anchorage next to Male. So, we will have the option to make a guided visit to Male.



### Day 8 (Saturday): MALE

Disembark at Male Airport at 07.00 am. If the return flight leaves in the afternoon there is an day hotel option near the airport, and even free time to optionally visit Male until the time of the return flight.

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## MALDIVES – SOUTH HEMISPHERE EXPEDITION “7 ATOLLS” & “SOUTH HEMISPHERE” ROUTES Onboard Maldives Blue Force One & 3

After the success of the previous expeditions and with the acquired experience, the **MALDIVES BLUE FORCE** team plan every year the **SOUTHERN HEMISPHERE EXPEDITION**. We have planned a safari mostly out of the usual diving sites in Maldives, from Male to the Deep South of the country and vice versa, exclusively in the months when there are optimal conditions.

Maldives Southern Hemisphere safaris run with 2 routes and different sites: **7 ATOLLS route** and **SOUTH HEMISPHERE route**.

-  **Week 1:** 7 ATOLLS route (“DEEP SOUTH DOWN”) “Male - Kooddoo”
-  **Middle weeks:** “SOUTH HEMISPHERE” route  
“Kooddoo - Gan” or “Gan - Kooddoo”
-  **Last week:** 7 ATOLLS route (“DEEP SOUTH UP”) “Kooddoo - Male”

Going 2 weeks consecutively is highly recommended. We call this option **SOUTH HEMISPHERE FULL EXPEDITION ROUTE**. From Male in the central atolls to Addu, in the Deep South of Maldives or vice versa. It offers an exceptional and full Liveaboard experience for 2 weeks.

7 ATOLLS ROUTE (DEEP SOUTH DOWN or DEEP SOUTH UP)

 **Days 2 - 7 Sunday - Friday: “7 ATOLLS” DIVING CRUISE**  
Dive in North Male, South Male, Vaavu, Meemu, Thaa, Laamu & Gaafu Alifu. 3 dives a day, including 1 or 2 night dives in the week. Depending on the diving conditions, the number of daily dives can be modified, guaranteeing a total amount of 18 dives per week. If the weather and logistic allow, we will have a BBQ lunch on a desert island and will visit a fisherman village.

 **Day 8 Saturday: DISEMBARKING ATOLL – MALE**  
Disembarking early in the morning.  
For those who make the “Deep South Down” week 1: domestic flight Kooddoo – Male. Arrival at Male airport. For those who make the “Deep South Up”: Disembark at Male Airport at 07.00 am. If the return flight leaves in the afternoon there is a day hotel option near the airport, and even free time to optionally visit Male until the time of the return flight.

Arrival at Male Airport. Connecting flight from Male – Embarking atoll airport Kooddoo or Gan. One of our staff members will be waiting for you at airport. You will then get onto our auxiliary boat Dhoni for the transfer to MALDIVES BLUE FORCE ONE or 3 for check in, briefing of the liveaboard, diving and plan itinerary. Dinner onboard.

#### Day 2 - 7 Sunday-Friday: SOUTH HEMISPHERE DIVING CRUISE

Dive in Addu, Gaafu Alifu, Gaafu Dhaalu & Fuvahmulah. 3 dives a day, including 1 or 2 night dives in the week. Depending on the diving conditions, the number of daily dives can be modified, guaranteeing a total amount of 18 dives per week.

If the weather and logistic allow, we will have a BBQ lunch on a desert island and will visit a fishermen village. Last day arrival at Kooddoo or Gan, cleaning of equipment and relax on board.

#### Day 8 Saturday: GAN or KOODDOO – MALE

Early morning disembarking. Domestic flight to Male.

 **Important:** This route is recommended only for experienced divers due to its difficulty, so a minimum Advanced Open water level or similar, have logged at least 100 dives and diving with NITROX.

## “SOUTH HEMISPHERE” ROUTE (7 nights)


#### SOUTH HEMISPHERE ROUTE “Kooddoo – Gan” or “Gan - Kooddoo”


##### Most interesting spots of the “Southern Hemisphere” route:

 **GAAFU ALIFU & GAAFU DHAALU:** Doing the “Southern Hemisphere” route, you will have the opportunity to go more in depth into one of the most beautiful atolls of the Maldives, Gaafu Alifu and Gaafu Dhaalu, visiting all its marvelous places. The famous Vilingili and Kooddoo channels of are only a part of the many attractions that this huge atoll has to offer. We also find densely coral populated thilas like Bodu Thila, labyrinthic Kondey coral garden, blue dives next to the reef like Gemmanafushi Beru where we go out to find hammerhead and silky sharks and more.

We will also have the chance to do nighttime activities like night dives in the reef and snorkeling with whale shark, mantas, dolphins, and nurse sharks.

During the week, we will find a quiet island or sandbank where we will enjoy a barbeque and spend time with activities such as paddleboarding, kayaking and snorkeling. We can also enjoy a sunset on the sandbank in the evenings with music and drinks, or just walk around one of the local islands.

 **ADDU:** Famous for its manta dives at Maa Kanduu cleaning station where we can enjoy the presence of these majestic creatures. Addu is also home to the largest wreck in the Maldives, The British Loyalty, 150 meters! But not only that, in this atoll we also find incredible blue walls where we have the chance to find tiger, silvertip and grey reef sharks.

 **FUVAHMULAH:** One of the main attractions of this route, Fuvahmulah is where we will spend one of our days during the trip. This island south of the equator offers exciting dives such as the southern plateau, with strong currents, we will have the chance to see from hammerhead sharks to thresher and tiger sharks, or the famous Tiger Zoo or Tiger Wall where we will have the opportunity to see tiger sharks up close, with the possibility to choose the “attracting” dives (hiding waste from the fish processing plant under the rocks). Other pelagic animals are common in Fuvahmulah (Tunas, jack fish, marlin, etc.)



**IMPORTANT:** These routes are only suitable for experienced divers; the dive sites are known for very strong current, and the dives can be quite hard. Therefore, we require at least an Advanced Open water level or similar, have logged at least 100 dives and diving with NITROX.





## "THE BEST OF THE MALDIVES" ROUTE (10 & 11 NIGHTS)

 **January (Saturday to Tuesday), 10 nights:** Boarding in Male and debarking in Addu (Gan airport)

 **January (Tuesday to Saturday), 11 nights:** Boarding in Addu (Gan airport) and debarking in Male

**Itinerary:** The atolls of Addu, Fuvahmulah, Gaafu Alifu, Gaafu Dhaalu, Laamu, Thaa, Meemu, Vaavu and Ari.

**Objectives for this route:** Mantas on cleaning stations in Addu, mantas at night, nurse sharks in Vaavu, pelagic life and schools of sharks in the channels of Meemu, Laamu and Gaafu, whale sharks at night in Thaa, tiger sharks and silver tip sharks in Fuvahmulah, the largest wreck in the Maldives and mantas in Gan.

Our team at **MALDIVES BLUE FORCE 3** has planned the live aboard season in the Atolls of southern Maldives for the months in which the conditions are optimum for diving in this area of the country. In 2024 the boat will start its Southern Maldives season with two exceptional 10 and 11 nights liveaboards leaving from Male and ending in Addu and vice versa. By extending the amount of days on board, this route permits us to dive, on the same trip, what can possibly be considered the **"BEST OF THE MALDIVES"**.

This route is exceptional and for the most part, off of the normal path that most liveaboards follow. Besides the extended amount of days on board from 7 to 10 or 11, with the obvious increment of dives we will be making, what is most amazing is the quality of the sites we will be allowed to reach. The amount of life we will be able to observe: large schools of jacks, schools of grey sharks, silky sharks, whale sharks at night sometimes in the day as well, mantas, tiger sharks, silver tip sharks, Marlins and even the occasional and elusive Oceanic Sun Fish (mola mola). As well as the quality and exuberance of the coral reefs around here, the thilas with their spectacular reefs and the nurse sharks from Alimatha, really make this route **the BEST OF THE MALDIVES**.





## "THE BEST OF THE MALDIVES" ROUTE (10 & 11 NIGHTS)


Bellow is a more detailed look at the atolls we will be diving on this route:


 **VAAVU:** Without a doubt, the top dive sites on this atoll are Miyaru Kandu, the Alimathaa Pier and Fotteyo Kandu.

Miyaru Kandu is a spectacular channel near the island of Alimathaa where we will be able to watch many grey reef sharks, silver tip sharks and black tips reef sharks.


Alimathaa Pier is famous for the nurse shark dive, where you will be surrounded by dozens of these amazingly docile animals. An extremely unique experience!

In Fotteyo Kandu we find amazing yellow soft coral, schools of jack fish, tunas and sometimes hammerhead sharks.

 **MEEMU:** This incredible atoll, is where we go to enjoy rich channels teeming with life, such as the channel of Vanhuravelhi. We also find breathtaking dives like Muli Corner, where you never know what the ocean is going to surprise you with, or the manta cleaning station at Kureli Manta point.

 **THAA:** We will enjoy diving the colorful Dhifushi Kandu during the day and, during the night, we wait for the chance to snorkel with gentle whale sharks, dancing mantas, curious dolphins, and sharks.

 **LAAMU:** With places like Fushi Kandu and Isdhoo Muli, where we can find schools of eagle rays, schools of jacks and the rather shy Hump head parrotfish. Hitadhoo corner also offers its Manta cleaning station.

 **GAAFU ALIFU & GAAFU DHAALU:** Adrenaline pumping dives in the most famous channels of Maldives like Vilingili Kandu, Kooddoo Kandu or Vodamula Kandu, with dozens of grey reef sharks, silvertips, blacktips, schools of jack fish, pod of dolphins and many more. We might also get some surprise appearances by whale sharks if the plankton is abundant.

Let's not forget to mention the pristine zones of almost untouched coral reefs like Kondey coral garden or diving with green turtles and eagle rays in Maarehaa Kandu. We try to visit deserted beaches and small fishing villages, where we get a glimpse of the authentic Maldivian life, far from tourism and living off fishing and agriculture as a way of life.


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 **ADDU:** Once base for the RAF & Royal Navy this tiny atoll below Ecuador, is house of some very interesting dive sites; mantas in Maa kandu cleaning station, the British Loyalty shipwreck (the biggest wreck in Maldives), the newly famous Hithadoo shark wall with silver tip sharks and appearances of tiger sharks, or the dives on the ocean corners among top-shaped corals, the night dive with humphead parrotfish and green turtles, pipefish... and out of the sea a walk along the promenade and a few drinks in one of its outdoor bars.

 **FUVAHMULAH:** If weather permits, because there is no fringing reef to offer protection, we will visit this peculiar island just south of the equator line, about 5 km long, where we can dive off the reef into the big blue. There we might encounter large schools of jacks, mantas and sharks, Napoleon wrasse as well, and possible "special encounters" like the elusive thresher shark, tiger shark, silver tip shark, marlin, oceanic sunfish... We will also try to dive the south wall of the island, one of the best-preserved coral reefs of the Maldives.

 **ARI:** In this Atoll, everything is possible, whale shark encounters, manta cleaning stations... however we are here for something different. We are here to enjoy one of the most exclusive dives in the Maldives, the manta night dive where we get to be a part of their night feeding dances.

During the cruise, we will find a quiet island or sandbank where we will enjoy a barbeque and activities such as paddleboarding, kayaking and snorkeling. We can also enjoy a sunset on the sandbank in the evenings with music and drinks, or just walk around one of the local islands.

**MALE AIRPORT – MALDIVES BLUE FORCE 3**

Arrival to Male airport. Pass through immigration. Pick up bags. Transfer to MALDIVES BLUE FORCE 3. Cabin assignment, boat briefing, dive briefing, itinerary... live aboard begins.



**Sunday to Monday:**

**LIVE ABOARD "BEST OF THE MALDIVES" ROUTE**

Diving on the Atolls of Ari, Vaavu, Meemu, Thaa, Laamu, Gaafu Alifu, Gaafu Dhaalu Fuvahmulah & Addu with an average 3 dives per day, including night dives. Depending on the diving conditions, the number of daily dives can vary, but we guarantee a total of 27 dives for this route.

We will combine diving with visits to the islands, sunset chillouts, kayaking, paddle boarding and relax time...

Last day arriving at Addu, rinsing dive gear and relaxing on board.



**Tuesday:**

**ADDU ATOLL- MALE AIRPORT**

Disembarking in the morning, to the airport of Gan. Flight from Gan to Male (flight times to be determined). Arrival at Male airport.

**LIVE ABOARD "BEST OF THE MALDIVES" ROUTE**
